Untangling Two Sidney Porters of Hadley, Massachusetts and Farmington, Connecticut

One morning in the fall of 1822, a young salesman for a Connecticut clock maker stepped off the stage to have breakfast near Kings Crossroads in Guilford County, North Carolina. It is said that by the time breakfast was over and the stage was ready to continue its journey, Sidney Porter had decided to stay.^[2] A year and a half later, Sidney Porter married Ruth Coffin Worth.^[3] Ruth's brother Jonathan later became the governor of North Carolina.^[4] Sidney and Ruth went on to have nine children,^[5] the eldest being Algernon Sidney Porter, father of William Sydney Porter,^[6] also known as short story author O. Henry.

In 1984 Gary Boyd Roberts and the late William Addams Reitwiesner published *American Ancestors and Cousins of The Princess of Wales*.^[7] Among those listed as a cousin of Princess Diana is William Sydney Porter.^[8] This kinship to Princess Diana is said to be through William Sydney Porter's grandfather Sidney Porter, husband of Ruth Coffin Worth. Roberts and Reitwiesner identified Sidney Porter as the son of Eleazar and Sarah (Keyes) Porter Jr.,^[9] of Hadley, Massachusetts. Roberts has informed this author that the identification was based on genealogical charts published in Ethel Stephens Arnett's *From England to North Carolina: Two Special Gifts*.^[10]

At first glance, this identification for Sidney Porter would seem to be correct. Sidney and Ruth Porter named a son Algernon Porter. Sidney's alleged sister Maria, daughter of Eleazar Porter Jr. and wife of Samuel Bayard Woodward, also named a son Algernon.^[11] With both Sidney and Maria giving a child the uncommon name of Algernon, it seems to support the idea that the two were siblings. However, there is evidence that creates doubt with this identification.

The town records of Hadley, Massachusetts, contain the birth dates for nine children of Eleazar Porter Jr. "& Sarah his Wife." Their sixth child, Sidney Porter was born 29 September 1795.^[12] However, the gravestone for Sidney Porter, who died at North Carolina in 1848 and is buried alongside his wife Ruth, has the inscription that he was born "in Connecticut Feb. 2, 1790."^[13] Also, an obituary appeared in the *Hartford Courant* noting the death of Sidney Porter "a native of Farmington in this State." Other evidence includes published genealogies that identify the wife of Sidney Porter, son of Eleazar, as either Hannah or Harriett Lane and not Ruth Coffin Worth.^[14] In spite of these, the identification of Sidney Porter, husband of Ruth, as the son of Eleazar and Sarah (Keyes) Porter Jr. still prevails to this day on major genealogical websites.^[15] The fact that no Connecticut birth record has been found for Sidney Porter of Farmington, Connecticut, may

have contributed to Sidney Porter of Hadley, Massachusetts, being identified as the husband of Ruth Coffin Worth simply through the process of elimination.

The purpose of this article is to present additional evidence that definitively shows that Sidney Porter of Hadley, Massachusetts, was not the husband of Ruth Coffin Worth, and to identify the Sidney Porter of Farmington, Connecticut, who was.

Sidney Porter of Hadley, Massachusetts

Sidney Porter, son of Eleazar and Sarah (Keyes) Porter Jr., married Hannah Lane, daughter of Rev. Otis and Elizabeth (Paine) Lane. They were married by Hannah's father at Sterling, Connecticut, 8 October 1829.^[16] The couple were married for over four decades; however, they apparently spent much of that time apart. The 1860 U.S. Census and the 1865 Connecticut State Census show Sidney Porter living, without his wife, at his brother David Keys Porter's home in Sturbridge, Massachusetts.^[17] After David died in 1868,^[18] Sidney is found in the 1870 U.S. Census living in the household of Francis and Rebecca Cooper at Sturbridge.^[19]

During most of the 1870s, Sidney's wife Hannah (Lane) Porter was living in Olivet, Michigan, working as the matron of the Ladies' Hall at Olivet College.^[20] Hannah is buried in the Oak Ridge Cemetery at Southbridge, Massachusetts. She shares a tombstone with her brother Samuel Lane, which is inscribed "Hannah Lane Porter, 1809-1895."^[21] Samuel Lane is mentioned in the Worcester County, Massachusetts, probate records for the estate of his brother-in-law Sidney Porter. Sidney and Hannah (Lane) Porter had no surviving children as indicated by the Administrator's Petition in the probate file for the estate of Sidney Porter. The Administrator's Petition identifies Sidney's widow as Hannah L. Porter and his "only next of kin" as his brother "Eleazar Porter of Stamford Ct."^[22] Sidney and Eleazar's siblings had all died prior to 1874.^[23]

Sidney Porter is buried in the Woodland Cemetery at Stamford, Connecticut.^[24] His grave is in the family plot of his brother, Eleazar Porter.^[25] Eleazar Porter was born 26 August 1799 as the eighth child of Eleazar Porter Jr. and Sarah Keys.^[26] The inscription on Sidney's gravestone gives his birth date as 29 September 1795 and his death date as 24 December 1873. Eleazar Porter's gravestone inscription gives his birth date as 26 August 1799 and his death date as 7 January 1884. Although Sidney's memorial and image of his gravestone can be found on FindaGrave.com, as of this writing, he is incorrectly identified as the wife of his brother, Eleazar Porter. Based on the birth dates in the Hadley town records and on the gravestones for Sidney and Eleazar Porter, there can be no doubt that these graves are for the toms of Eleazar Jr. and Sarah (Keyes) Porter.^[27] Based on the evidence above, Sidney Porter of Hadley, Massachusetts, son of Eleazar and Sarah (Keyes) Porter Jr., was not the husband of Ruth Coffin Worth as identified by Roberts and Reitwiesner.

Genealogical Summary

1. ELEAZAR PORTER JR.⁶ was born at Hadley, Mass., 14 June 1762, son of Eleazer⁵ (*Eleazer⁴*, *Samuel³*, *Samuel²*, *John¹*) and Susanna (Edwards) Porter.^[28] He died at Sturbridge, Mass., 2 May 1849 and was buried there in North Cemetery.^[29]

Eleazar Porter Jr. married at Hadley, 5 January 1783, SARAH KEYES.^[30] She was born at Warren, Mass., 8 October 1761, daughter of David and Submit (Belding) Keyes.^[31] Sarah died at Sturbridge, 26 March 1838 and was buried there in North Cemetery.^[32]

2. **SIDNEY PORTER**² was born at Hadley, Mass., 29 September 1795.^[43] He died 24 December 1873 and was buried in Woodland Cemetery, Stamford, Conn.^[44]

Sidney Porter married **Hannah Lane** at Sterling, Conn., 8 October 1829.^[45] Hannah was born at Sturbridge, Mass., 13 January 1809, daughter of Rev. Otis and Elizabeth (Paine) Lane.^[46] She died at Southbridge, Mass., 27 February 1895 and was buried there in Oak Ridge Cemetery.^[47] They had no known children.


Sidney Porter, of Farmington, Connecticut

Kathy Russell-Regan^[48] grew up hearing from her father the story that her greatgrandfather was a cousin to the author O. Henry. In December 2020, Kathy's hather, Jack Arlen Russell, passed away and "in his storage was about 40 boxes, orates, and trunks." Kathy added, "The boxes have been in California for over 100 years. I was pretty blown away that I am 65 and just seeing this stuff for the first time." Among the contents were an old trunk, books, bibles, letters, photos, deeds, G.A.R. artifacts, family registers, a beautifully hand-drawn and framed family tree, and many other items dating from as early as the eighteenth century. There were also artifacts such as a teapot and baptismal cloth labeled with the names of their eighteenth century owners. Kathy had inherited a gold mine of family history with many of the items having belonged to members of the Porter family of Farmington, Connecticut.

One of the items Kathy Russell-Regan inherited was an old family register for the family of William and Sarah (Lusk) Porter listing the birth and death dates of their children.^[49] Listed among the children of William and Sarah is Sidney Porter, born 2 February 1790, a date identical to that inscribed on the tombstone of Sidney Porter, husband of Ruth Coffin Worth.^[50] Although no birth records have been found in the Farmington vital records for any of the children of William and Sarah, the discovery of this family register was crucial to finding the baptisms of seven of their children, including son Sidney. Certainly, the reason Sidney's baptism was not found previously is because the seven children were all baptized on the same date when Sidney was seven years old. The baptismal records for the Farmington First Congregational Church showed that Sidney Porter, and six of his siblings listed on the family register, were baptized there 11 October 1797.^[51]

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Another item that Kathy Russell-Regan inherited was a family tree for the family of Sidney and Ruth Coffin (Worth) Porter, the grandparents of William Sydney Porter. The family tree consists of a framed, hand drawn tree that contains the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of "Sidney Porter, Son of William & Sarah Porter" and "Ruth Coffin Worth, Daughter of Dr. David & Eunice Worth." Each child's family is drawn as a tree limb branching out from the trunk with the grandchildren and great-grandchildren written as branches off the child's limb. Although it does not give Sidney or Ruth's birth or death dates. it does begin with their marriage date of 22 April 1824 written at the base of the trunk. It would appear the family tree was created after the 1824 marriage and updated with their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren until about 1895 (great-grandchildren's births). Among those listed is son Algernon Sidney Porter, his wife Mary V. Swaim, and grandson Wm. Sidney Porter, also known as O. Henry, with his first wife Athol Estes. William's second wife, Sara Coleman, does not appear on the tree as he married her after the tree was no longer being updated.



There can be no doubt that Sidney Porter of Farmington, Connecticut, son of William and Sarah (Lusk) Porter, was the man who stepped off the stage at Guildford County in 1822, and that it was he who married Ruth Coffin Worth.

Genealogical Summary

1. WILLIAM PORTER⁵ was born 4 February 1745, son of David⁴ (*William³*, *Thomas²*, *Robert¹*) and Annah (Judd) (Moodey) Porter.^[52] He died at Farmington, Conn., 4 or 6 March 1826 and was buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Avon, Conn.^[53]

William Porter married at Farmington, 26 or 30 May 1776, SARAH LUSK.^[54] She was born 24 November 1755, daughter of James and his first wife Sarah

(Paterson) Lusk.^[55] Sarah died at Avon, 12 December 1833 and was buried there in Greenwood Cemetery.^[56]

2. SIDNEY PORTER⁶ was born 2 Feb. 1790 and baptized with six siblings at Farmington, Conn., 11 Oct. 1797.^[68] He died at Greensboro, N.C., 8 Feb. 1848 and is buried there in the First Presbyterian Church Cemetery.^[69]

Sidney Porter married at Centre Community, N.C., 22 April 1824, **Ruth Coffin** Worth.^[70] She was born there 3 June 1805, daughter of Dr. David and Eunice (Gardner) Worth.^[71] Ruth died at Greensboro, 17 August 1890 and was buried there in the First Presbyterian Church Cemetery.^[72]
